The Internet Code

Pupils will:

- ask permission before using the internet.
- only make searches as instructed by staff
- only create content, including photos/videos, that I would be happy to share
- turn off my monitor/tablet and tell my teacher immediately if I accidentally find anything I feel uncomfortable with.
- only use my school email account to email people an adult has approved
- only send e-mails that are polite, friendly and responsible.
- only open e-mails sent from someone I know .
- *never* give my personal details, including my name, phone number and home address.
- *never* arrange to meet anyone I do not know.
- *never* use internet chat rooms or other forms of social media at school
- behave responsibly when using ICT
- I know that my use of ICT will be checked and that my parent/carer will be contacted if a member of staff is concerned about my use of e-Safety.
