Dear Parents/Carers,

Congratulations also to Jack B., Lottie, Rebecca, Aaron, Lucy and Fenella who have now achieved twenty house-points!

Winter Weather: Now that the colder weather is upon us, we would like to remind you of the school's procedure should we need to close at short notice. Whilst we make every effort to remain open, many families and staff members travel reasonable distances to school so the need to close will be out of concern for the safety of pupils and staff. Should we have to close, we will aim to do the following as promptly as is possible:

- i) Send an email to all parents/carers.
- ii) Post an update on the school website.

Over the coming weeks, please ensure that your children come to school dressed appropriately for the weather – all children <u>must</u> wear a coat to school.

Online Payment System: Following parental feedback, we are in the process of setting up an online payment system. Initially, this system will be for dinner money (for Years 3 – 6 only) and trips, but over time it will include clubs (including Breakfast Club). We really appreciate your feed-back and are hopeful that the new system will make payments to the school more efficient. You will soon be receiving details about how to sign up for this system.

Christmas Post-Box: As of next week, we will have a Christmas Post-box in the hall. If your child/ren would like to send Christmas cards to their friends, please ask them to post their cards in the post-box and children in Year 6 will then sort them at lunch-time. (Please encourage your child to write either the child's year group and/or the initial of their surname on the envelope, i.e. **James P. Year 1** to avoid confusion over who receives the cards!)

Travelling Crib: As in previous years, we are supporting the church's Travelling Crib this year. The idea is that the crib, which includes Mary, Joseph (and donkey!) travels from family to family during each day of advent, representing the journey made to Bethlehem. If you would like to host the crib for one night during Advent, please speak to me on the playground before school.

Panto: A quick reminder that we have our whole school pantomime trip on Monday 18th December. The coaches are due to leave school at 9:00am, in light of this, *we are asking for all children to arrive at school no later than 8:30am on Monday 18th December,* in order that we can ensure they have all been registered and gone to the toilet before we depart. Please ensure any permission slips and contributions are returned to the office asap.

After School Clubs: Please be aware that <u>after school clubs are now finished for this term.</u> Next week, we will be writing to you regarding the after school clubs on offer for the Spring Term. Please be aware that if there are any outstanding club debts for your child, we will not be able to allocate them any clubs for the Spring Term, including Breakfast Club.

Penalty Shoot-Out: On Sunday 19th November, a group of children from Years 5&6 visited Watford Football Club to take part in a penalty shoot-out at half-time during a match between Watford vs West Ham. Whilst not victorious on this occasion, the children had a fantastic afternoon and got to play in front of thousands of fans! Many thanks to Mrs Todiresei for organising.

Writing Week: Last week, Miss Ayres organised a Writing Week to inspire and enthuse writing across the school and we are really delighted with the results. The children thoroughly enjoyed the experiences they had to support their writing. In addition, it was lovely to see so many parents join us on Friday afternoon to see the work that had been produced. Sincere thanks to Miss Ayres for organising such a super event!

Winter Art Exhibition: On Thursday 7th December, Mrs Lilley has organised a Winter Art Exhibition in the hall. Parents are invited to come into the hall (via the office) and see the work that the children have produced. In order that the hall is not over-crowded, we are suggesting that parents of children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 come in at 3:00pm and parents of children in Years 3 – 6 come in at 3:10pm. (If you have children in both groups, please come at the earlier time.) If your child is in Nursery, you are welcome to either pop into the classroom at 11:45am to see their work, or join us at 3:00pm for the exhibition in the hall. Your children will be able to leave with you, once you have enjoyed all there is to enjoy at the exhibition!

Christmas Tree Festival: This weekend, the church are hosting a Christmas Tree Festival with a great number of Christmas trees! Children across the school have contributed to a 'Forest Schools' themed tree. Huge thanks to Mrs Waites for designing the school's entry and for Mrs Edwards (one of our governors) for her support.

Christmas Jumper Day: On Friday 8th December, FOGGS are inviting all children (and staff!) to come to school in non-school uniform. The children are really enjoying his presence in the school and have enjoyed taking him for walks and visiting him in the library and office. We have invited Karen Tonge, a local dog-trainer into school to carry out dog bite prevention workshops for the children. The purpose of this work is to ensure that all of the children know how to stay safe around dogs. Donut has a lovely temperament and we are really noticing the positive impact he is having on the children.
