<p>Wednesday 1st November</p>	<p>Focus: English WALT: Write a recount. Task: I want to hear about your half term! Choose a day from the holidays to write a paragraph about. You might also have pictures, photos, leaflets from a day out or even a souvenir you could bring in to share with us.</p> <p>WILF:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Writing in the past tense about what you did. ➤ Time conjunctions (first, next, then, after that, later etc.) ➤ Amazing adjectives used to describe your day. <p>Spelling: Please see your child's Look, Cover, Write, Check sheet for their spelling score for this week. Please ensure they spend time each day completing a column of this week's spelling words. This is an opportunity to practice letter formation and handwriting as well as spelling.</p> <p>My Maths: Our Maths topics this half-term include number, shape and money. Please encourage your child to access these topics on My Maths.</p>		
<p>Wednesday 8th November</p>	<p>Focus: Science WALT: Observe over time. Task: Which materials float and which sink? Pick two different materials and discuss with an adult if you think they will float or sink when you put them in water. Then, you will need to test it with an adult to see if you were correct! You could test your materials in the sink or even in the bath. (You must be careful near water and complete this homework with an adult).</p> <p>WILF:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Choose two different materials. ➤ Write a prediction about whether they will sink or float. ➤ Test and record your results. <p>Spelling: Please see your child's Look, Cover, Write, Check sheet for their spelling score for this week. Please ensure they spend time each day completing a column of this week's spelling words. This is an opportunity to practice letter formation and handwriting as well as spelling.</p> <p>My Maths: Our Maths topics this half-term include number, shape and money. Please encourage your child to access these topics on My Maths.</p>		
<p>Wednesday 15th November</p>	<p>Focus: History WALT: Research life in the 17th Century. Task: Continuing our learning of life in London in the 17th Century, I want you to research a different area of life. This could be – transport, buildings, homes or food. Think about questions you want to answer. For example, how did people get around? What were buildings made out of? How did people heat their homes? What did people eat? How did they get water? What did people use for light?</p>		

	<p>WILF:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ At least three facts about an area of life in 17th Century London. <p>Spelling: Please see your child's Look, Cover, Write, Check sheet for their spelling score for this week. Please ensure they spend time each day completing a column of this week's spelling words. This is an opportunity to practice letter formation and handwriting as well as spelling.</p> <p>My Maths: Our Maths topics this half-term include number, shape and money. You can be as creative as you wish! Please include a photo or a drawn picture of your shape picture.</p> <p>WILF:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Hunt around the house for as many different 2D and 3D objects as you can! ➤ Create a simple picture using your 2D and 3D objects! <p>Spelling: Please see your child's Look, Cover, Write, Check sheet for their spelling score for this week. Please ensure they spend time each day completing a column of this week's spelling words. This is an opportunity to practice letter formation and handwriting as well as spelling.</p> <p>My Maths: Our Maths topics this half-term include number, shape and money. <p>Wednesday 29th November</p>	<p>Focus: English</p> <p>WALT: Ask and write questions.</p> <p>Task: Read the next 10 pages of your school reading book. Think about who the main characters of your story are. If you could ask them any question what would you ask? All questions will start with one of the following words 'Who, When, Where, What, Why, How or Do'</p> <p>WILF:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Read the next 10 pages of your reading book to an adult. ➤ Discuss with an adult the questions you would like to ask the main character. ➤ Write your 5 questions neatly in your homework book. ➤ Remember all questions must end with a question mark (?) <p>Spelling: Please see your child's Look, Cover, Write, Check sheet for their spelling score for this week. Use amazing adjectives to describe it! ➤ Explain why you deserve your gift using the word 'because'. <p>Spelling: Please see your child's Look, Cover, Write, Check sheet for their spelling score for this week. Please ensure they spend time each day completing a column of this week's spelling words.
