On Tuesday, we were visited by Jane & Amanda from the NSPCC, who delivered their 'Speak Out. Stay Safe' workshop to Years 2, 5 & 6. In addition, children in Years 1, 3 & 4 watched the NSPCC assembly and discussed ways in which they can keep themselves safe.

At an age-appropriate level, the children were taught to:-

- understand abuse in all its forms and recognise the signs of abuse
- understand that abuse is never a child's fault, and they have the right to be safe
- know how to get help, and the sources of help available to them, including our Childline service.
